ESV	In his days Edom revolted from the rule of Judah and set up a king of their own.
NIV	In the time of Jehoram, Edom rebelled against Judah and set up its own king.
NLT	During Jehoram's reign, the Edomites revolted against Judah and crowned their own king.
LXX	ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ταῖς greek The definite article ἡμέραις αὐτοῦ greek αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἡθέτησεν Εδωμ ὑποκάτωθεν χειρὸς Ιουδα καὶ autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐβασίλευσαν ἐφ’ ἑαυτοὺς βασιλέα
KJV	In his days Edom revolted from under the hand of Judah, and made a king over themselves.

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
