ESV	So Edom revolted from the rule of Judah to this day. Then Libnah revolted at the same time.
NIV	To this day Edom has been in rebellion against Judah. Libnah revolted at the same time.
NLT	So Edom has been independent from Judah to this day. The town of Libnah also revolted about that same time.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἡθέτησεν Εδωμ ὑποκάτωθεν χειρὸς Ιουδα ἕως τῆς greek The definite article ἡμέρας ταύτης οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 τότε ἡθέτησεν Λοβενά ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἐν greek The definite article καὶ ἐκεῖνος
KJV	Yet Edom revolted from under the hand of Judah unto this day. Then Libnah revolted at the same time.
