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|     | <p>הִיָּה <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>הִיָּה</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>The word הִיָּה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</p> <p>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</p> <p>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2</p> <p>שָׁמַר <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>Examples</p> <p>שָׁמַר</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend</p> <p>The verb שָׁמַר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament.</p> <p>Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 <span>פָּנִים</span> <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>פָּנִים</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* Face * Presence * Front or surface</p> <p>Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. <span>חִזְאֵל מֶלֶךְ אֲרָם</span></p> |

It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
