Hebrew	The word וַיְהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 כָּלֵתוּ לְדַבֵּר וַחֲנָה בְּנֵי הַמֶּלֶךְ בָּאוּ וַיִּשְׁאֲזוּ קוֹלָם וַיִּבְכּוּ וְגַם הַמֶּלֶךְ וְכָל עַבְדָּיו בָּכּוּ בְּכִי גָדוֹל מְאֹד
ESV	And as soon as he had finished speaking, behold, the king's sons came and lifted up their voice and wept. And the king also and all his servants wept very bitterly.
