This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הַמִּלְחָמָה בֵּי־יֶעֱר אֶפְרַיִם
ESV	So the army went out into the field against Israel, and the battle was fought in the forest of Ephraim.
NIV	The army marched into the field to fight Israel, and the battle took place in the forest of Ephraim.
NLT	So the battle began in the forest of Ephraim,
