In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by

ESV	For your servant knows that I have sinned. Therefore, behold, I have come this day, the first of all the house of Joseph to come down to meet my lord the king.”
NIV	For I your servant know that I have sinned, but today I have come here as the first of the whole house of Joseph to come down and meet my lord the king.”
NLT	I know how much I sinned. That is why I have come here today, the very first person in all Israel to greet my lord the king.”

IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἰδοὺ ἐγὼ ἦλθον σήμερον πρότερος παντός greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
