NIV	The king covered his face and cried aloud, "O my son Absalom! O Absalom, my son, my son!"
NLT	The king covered his face with his hands and kept on crying, "O my son Absalom! O Absalom, my son, my son!"
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ὁ greek The definite article βασιλεὺς ἔκρυσεν τὸ greek The definite article πρόσωπον αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
