	שָׁמַר Meaning: Hebrew * To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend The verb שָׁמַר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament. Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 לְרֹאשׁ גּוֹיִם עִם לֹא יִדְעֵתִי יַעֲבֹדֵנִי
ESV	“You delivered me from strife with my people; you kept me as the head of the nations; people whom I had not known served me.
NIV	“You have delivered me from the attacks of my people; you have preserved me as the head of nations. People I did not know are subject to me,
NLT	“You gave me victory over my accusers. You preserved me as the ruler over nations; people I don't even know now serve me.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ῥύσῃ με ἐκ μάχης λαῶν φυλάξεις με εἰς κεφαλὴν ἔθνῶν λαός ὃν οὐκ ἔγνων ἐδόουλεύσαν μοι
KJV	Thou also hast delivered me from the strivings of my people, thou hast kept me to be head of the heathen: a people which I knew not shall serve me.

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
