	<p>The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.</p>
	<p>For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by שֵׁם בְּשַׁלְשָׁה וְלוֹ שְׁלֹשׁ מְאֹת הַלֵּל וְלוֹ שְׁלֹשׁ מְאֹת הַלֵּל</p>
ESV	<p>Now Abishai, the brother of Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief of the thirty. And he wielded his spear against three hundred men and killed them and won a name beside the three.</p>
NIV	<p>Abishai the brother of Joab son of Zeruiah was chief of the Thirty. He raised his spear against three hundred men, whom he killed, and so he became as famous as the Three.</p>
NLT	<p>Abishai son of Zeruiah, the brother of Joab, was the leader of the Thirty. He once used his spear to kill 300 enemy warriors in a single battle. It was by such feats that he became as famous as the Three.</p>
