	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (אַבְּנֵר בֶּן נֵר
ESV	So all the people and all Israel understood that day that it had not been the king's will to put to death Abner the son of Ner.
NIV	So on that day all the people and all Israel knew that the king had no part in the murder of Abner son of Ner.
NLT	So everyone in Judah and all Israel understood that David was not responsible for Abner's murder.
