IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὁ greek The definite article ἡθερααμ τῆς greek The definite article Αιγλα γυναικὸς Δαυιδ οὗτοι οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐτέχθησαν τῶ greek The definite article Δαυιδ ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. Χεβρων
