	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (אֹיְבַי לְפָגַי כְּפָרֵץ מֵיִם עַל כַּׁן קָרֶא שֵׁם הַמְּקוֹם הַהָּוּא בַּעַל פְּרָצִים
