Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by ברא אלהים (ארם בגיא מלח שמונה עשר אלף)
ESV	And David made a name for himself when he returned from striking down 18,000 Edomites in the Valley of Salt.
NIV	And David became famous after he returned from striking down eighteen thousand Edomites in the Valley of Salt.
NLT	So David became very famous. After his return he destroyed 18,000 Edomites in the Valley of Salt.
