	Meaning	
	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" μὴ ὡς ἐχθρὸν ἡγεῖσθε, ἀλλὰ νοουθετεῖτε ὡς ἀδελφόν.	
ESV	Do not regard him as an enemy, but warn him as a brother.	
NIV	Yet do not regard him as an enemy, but warn him as a brother.	
NLT	Don't think of them as enemies, but warn them as you would a brother or sister.	
KJV	Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.	

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
