Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Greek Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:16 1 John 5:11 1 Corinthians 15:50 1 John 4:9 John 5:1 Matthew 3:17 John 7:26 Luke 22:19 πάσχω, ἀλλ' οὐκ ἐπαισχύνομαι, οἶδα γὰρ ὃ ἐπίστευκα, καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" πέπεισμαι ὅτι δυνατός ἐστιν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τὴν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article παραθήκην μου φυλάξει εἰς ἐκείνην τὴν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article ἡμέραν.
