Greek	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 κακοπάθησον, ἔργον ποίησον plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιέω Meaning: * To do * To make This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship. ESV	As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

KJV	But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

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
