Greek	Καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ταῖςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article ἡμέραις ταύταιςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὔτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὔτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἀναστὰς Πέτρος ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. μέσω τῶνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article ἀδελφῶν εἶπεν ἦνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τε ὄχλος ὀνομάτων ἐπὶ τὸplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article αὐτὸplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὥσει ἐκατὸν εἴκοσι,
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ESV	In those days Peter stood up among the brothers (the company of persons was in all about 120) and said,
NIV	In those days Peter stood up among the believers (a group numbering about a hundred and twenty)
NLT	During this time, when about 120 believers were together in one place, Peter stood up and addressed them.
KJV	And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the disciples, and said, (the number of names together were about an hundred and twenty,)

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
