	οὖτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19
ESV	For he was numbered among us and was allotted his share in this ministry."
NIV	he was one of our number and shared in this ministry."
NLT	Judas was one of us and shared in the ministry with us."
KJV	For he was numbered with us, and had obtained part of this ministry.
