It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἡμέρας ἦνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. KJV	Now as soon as it was day, there was no small stir among the soldiers, what was become of Peter.
