	τακτῇ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἡμέρᾱ ὅ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... αὐτούς· greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
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ESV	On an appointed day Herod put on his royal robes, took his seat upon the throne, and delivered an oration to them.
NIV	On the appointed day Herod, wearing his royal robes, sat on his throne and delivered a public address to the people.
NLT	and an appointment with Herod was granted. When the day arrived, Herod put on his royal robes, sat on his throne, and made a speech to them.
KJV	And upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them.

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
