δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” συναγαγόντες τὴν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

greek

The definite article ἐκκλησίαν ἀνήγγελλον ὅσα ἐποίησεν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιέω

Meaning:

* To do * To make

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

The definite article θεὸς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God μετ’ αὐτῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

Meaning

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

The definite article ἔθνεσιν θύραν πίστεως.

ESV	And when they arrived and gathered the church together, they declared all that God had done with them, and how he had opened a door of faith to the Gentiles.
NIV	On arriving there, they gathered the church together and reported all that God had done through them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles.
NLT	Upon arriving in Antioch, they called the church together and reported everything God had done through them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles, too.
KJV	And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles.

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
