	Οἱ greek The definite article μὲν οὖν ἀπολυθέντες κατήλθον εἰς Ἀντιόχειαν, καὶ greek Meaning Greek * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” συναγαγόντες τὸ greek The definite article πλῆθος ἐπέδωκαν τὴν greek The definite article ἐπιστολήν·
ESV	So when they were sent off, they went down to Antioch, and having gathered the congregation together, they delivered the letter.
NIV	The men were sent off and went down to Antioch, where they gathered the church together and delivered the letter.
NLT	The messengers went at once to Antioch, where they called a general meeting of the believers and delivered the letter.
KJV	So when they were dismissed, they came to Antioch: and when they had gathered the multitude together, they delivered the epistle:

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
