It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τῷ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὃ greek The definite article τὸν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὃ greek The definite article Ἀπολλῷ εἶναι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἶμι greek εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμι is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. NIV	While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples
NLT	While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul traveled through the interior regions until he reached Ephesus, on the coast, where he found several believers.
