	πολλοί τε τῶν greek The definite article πεπιστευκότων ἤρχοντο ἐξομολογούμενοι καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀναγγέλλοντες τὰς greek The definite article πράξεις αὐτῶν. greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
ESV	Also many of those who were now believers came, confessing and divulging their practices.
NIV	Many of those who believed now came and openly confessed their evil deeds.
NLT	Many who became believers confessed their sinful practices.
KJV	And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds.

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
