It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. εἰς τὴνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article Μακεδονίαν δύο τῶνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article διακονούντων αὐτῷ,plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. ESV	And having sent into Macedonia two of his helpers, Timothy and Erastus, he himself stayed in Asia for a while.

NIV	He sent two of his helpers, Timothy and Erastus, to Macedonia, while he stayed in the province of Asia a little longer.
NLT	He sent his two assistants, Timothy and Erastus, ahead to Macedonia while he stayed awhile longer in the province of Asia.
KJV	So he sent into Macedonia two of them that ministered unto him, Timotheus and Erastus; but he himself stayed in Asia for a season.

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
