Greek	οὐ γὰρ Δαυεῖδ ἀνέβη εἰς τοὺς οὐρανοὺς greek The definite article οὐρανοὺς, Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 λέγει δὲ greek
	δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. αὐτός, greek
	Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	The definite article κυρίῳ μου, κάθου ἐκ δεξιῶν μου
ESV	For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, “The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand,
NIV	For David did not ascend to heaven, and yet he said, “The Lord said to my Lord: “Sit at my right hand
NLT	For David himself never ascended into heaven, yet he said, 'The LORD said to my Lord, “Sit in the place of honor at my right hand
KJV	For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

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
