It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example  $\epsilon l\mu l$  is the word for am and l is the word for was, e.g.  $\delta \epsilon plugin$ -autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip big $\delta \epsilon$
