Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀναχωρήσας κατ’ ἰδίαν ἐπυνθάνετο, τί ἐστὶν	
greek	
εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).	
It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁ	
greek	
Meaning:	
* Who * Which * What	
The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).	
It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἔχεις ἀπαγγεῖλαί μοι;	

ESV	The tribune took him by the hand, and going aside asked him privately, "What is it that you have to tell me?"
NIV	The commander took the young man by the hand, drew him aside and asked, "What is it you want to tell me?"
NLT	The commander took his hand, led him aside, and asked, "What is it you want to tell me?"
KJV	Then the chief captain took him by the hand, and went with him aside privately, and asked him, What is that thou hast to tell me?
