Meaning

\* He, she, it \* Himself, herself, itself \* Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

The definite article ἡγεμόνος λέγειν, ἐκ πολλῶν ἐτῶν ὄνταplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigεἰμί

Greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. σε κριτὴν τῷplugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigò

The definite article ἔθνει τούτωρlugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigoὖτος / αὕτη /τοῦτο

Meaning:

\* These or this \* This one, this person, this thing \* They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὖτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐπιστάμενος εὐθύμως τὰplugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigò

The definite article περὶ ἐμαυτοῦ ἀπολογοῦμαι,

**ESV** 

And when the governor had nodded to him to speak, Paul replied: "Knowing that for many years you have been a judge over this nation, I cheerfully make my defense.

NIV	When the governor motioned for him to speak, Paul replied: "I know that for a number of years you have been a judge over this nation; so I gladly make my defense.
