	* Not * Nor * Neither * Not even
	A combination of the words οὐ (meaning no) and δέ (meaning however or but). The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses. It often functions like English Matthew 6:20John 7:5Romans 3:10 παραστήσαι δύνανταί σοι περὶ ὧν νυνὶ κατηγοροῦσίν μου.
ESV	Neither can they prove to you what they now bring up against me.
NIV	And they cannot prove to you the charges they are now making against me.
NLT	These men cannot prove the things they accuse me of doing.
KJV	Neither can they prove the things whereof they now accuse me.

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
