It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning γενομένου). greek Meaning * To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass Verb. Different from εἶμι (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event. ESV	and when I was at Jerusalem, the chief priests and the elders of the Jews laid out their case against him, asking for a sentence of condemnation against him.
NIV	When I went to Jerusalem, the chief priests and elders of the Jews brought charges against him and asked that he be condemned.
NLT	When I was in Jerusalem, the leading priests and Jewish elders pressed charges against him and asked me to condemn him.
KJV	About whom, when I was at Jerusalem, the chief priests and the elders of the Jews informed me, desiring to have judgment against him.
