	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀποστείλῃ τὸν

	The definite article προκεχειρισμένον ὑμῖν Χριστόν,	
ESV	Christ means “anointed one”	
	The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)	
	Noun, masculine. Ἰησοῦν,
