	* To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass
	Verb.
	Different from εἶμι (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10
