Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and”

Meaning

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐποιήσατεplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιέω

Meaning:

* To do * To make

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

Verb forms

Present tense Person Greek Form ὑμεῖς;

ESV	And when they had set them in the midst, they inquired, "By what power or by what name did you do this?"
NIV	They had Peter and John brought before them and began to question them: "By what power or what name did you do this?"
NLT	They brought in the two disciples and demanded, "By what power, or in whose name, have you done this?"
KJV	And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?

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
