Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" τοὺς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἔσω, οὐδένα εὔρομεν.

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
