Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. ESV	And gazing at him, all who sat in the council saw that his face was like the face of an angel.
NIV	All who were sitting in the Sanhedrin looked intently at Stephen, and they saw that his face was like the face of an angel.
NLT	At this point everyone in the high council stared at Stephen, because his face became as bright as an angel's.
KJV	And all that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel.
