	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὅπως λάβωσιν πνεῦμα ἅγιον·
ESV	who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit,
NIV	When they arrived, they prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit,
NLT	As soon as they arrived, they prayed for these new believers to receive the Holy Spirit.
KJV	Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

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
