	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πεσὼν ἐπὶ τὴν
	greek
	The definite article γῆν
	Meaning:
	* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)
	Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.
	It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ἤκουσεν φωνὴν λέγουσαν αὐτῷ ,
	αὐτός
	greek
	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
	Σαοὺλ Σαοὺλ, τί με διώκεις;
ESV	And falling to the ground he heard a voice saying to him, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?”
NIV	He fell to the ground and heard a voice say to him, “Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?”
NLT	He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, “Saul! Saul! Why are you persecuting me?”
KJV	And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

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
