ESV	“Do two walk together, unless they have agreed to meet?
NIV	Do two walk together unless they have agreed to do so?
NLT	Can two people walk together without agreeing on the direction?
LXX	εἰ πορεύσονται δύο ἐπὶ τὸ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ αὐτὸ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
