ESV	They hate him who reproves in the gate, and they abhor him who speaks the truth.
NIV	you hate the one who reproves in court and despise him who tells the truth.

LXX	ἐμίσησαν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πύλαις ἐλέγχοντα καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” λόγον Meaning * A word or words * Statement * Message * Speech * Account * Used in John to mean God the Son Masculine noun. Related to the verb λέγω. λόγος in Greek Thought Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things. In Heraclitus, λόγος referred to the unifying rational principle behind the constant change in the world.... ὅσιον ἐβδελύξαντο
