Hebrew	הָסֵר מֵעָלַי הַמָּוֹן שִׁירֶיךָ וְזִמְרַת נְבִלָיִךְ לֹא אֶשְׁמָע
ESV	Take away from me the noise of your songs; to the melody of your harps I will not listen.
NIV	Away with the noise of your songs! I will not listen to the music of your harps.
NLT	Away with your noisy hymns of praise! I will not listen to the music of your harps.
LXX	μετάστησον ἀπ' ἐμοῦ ἥχον ὥδῶν σου καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ψαλμὸν ὀργάνων σου οὐκ ἀκούσομαι
KJV	Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.
