ESV	“Woe to those who lie on beds of ivory and stretch themselves out on their couches, and eat lambs from the flock and calves from the midst of the stall,
NIV	You lie on beds inlaid with ivory and lounge on your couches. You dine on choice lambs and fattened calves.
NLT	How terrible for you who sprawl on ivory beds and lounge on your couches, eating the meat of tender lambs from the flock and of choice calves fattened in the stall.
