The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 מַשָּׁם אוֹרֵי־דָם
ESV	“If they dig into Sheol, from there shall my hand take them; if they climb up to heaven, from there I will bring them down.
NIV	Though they dig down to the depths of the grave, from there my hand will take them. Though they climb up to the heavens, from there I will bring them down.
NLT	“Even if they dig down to the place of the dead, I will reach down and pull them up. Even if they climb up into the heavens, I will bring them down.
