Greek	Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 λέγω ἵνα μηδεὶς ὑμᾶς παραλογίζεται ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πιθανολογία.
ESV	I say this in order that no one may delude you with plausible arguments.
NIV	I tell you this so that no one may deceive you by fine-sounding arguments.
NLT	I am telling you this so no one will deceive you with well-crafted arguments.
KJV	And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.

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
