Hebrew	The word הַיְיָיִתִּי means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2עַל יְד הַנֶּחֱר הַגָּדוֹל הוּא חֲדָקֵל
ESV	On the twenty-fourth day of the first month, as I was standing on the bank of the great river (that is, the Tigris)

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KJV And in the four and twentieth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, which is Hiddekel;

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
