Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament.

Though usually feminine, רֹחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). The Hebrew **אֶת** word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article **הַ**. Genesis 1:1 **הַחֲלוּם**
