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Preposition meaning “in”. τῇplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article γῇplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγῇ

Meaning:

* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 πεφυτευμένον οὗ ἡplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article ὅρασις μεγάλη σὺ εἶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμί

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εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. βασιλεῦ

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
