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The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by (עמך מארץ) אלהים plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ארץ

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Meaning:

* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country

The word ארץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.

When coupled with heavens (שמים), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 מצרים ביד חזקה ותעש לך שם כיום הזה חטאנו רשענו

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
