In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (לִבְרֹאנוּ לְאֵמֹר עִם גְּדוֹל וְרֵם מִמֶּנּוּ עָרִים גְּדֹלֹת וּבְצוּרֹת שָׁמַיִם plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigבְּשָׁמַיִם hebrew Meanings: * Heaven or heavens * Sky * Compass Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present.
