* Yahweh - God's personal name

lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהְוָּה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

lt is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὄς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἐποίησαplugin-autotooltip_default pluginautotooltip_bigποιέω

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

lt an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐκεῖ καθὰ ἐνετείλατό μοι κύριος
